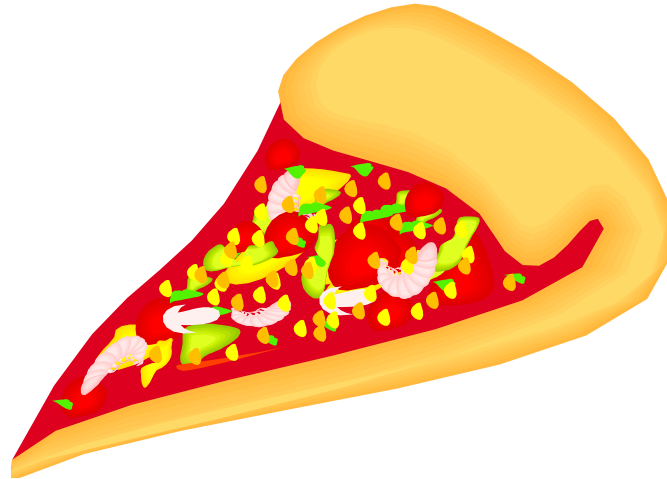


Perspectives?

 - Credit cards number



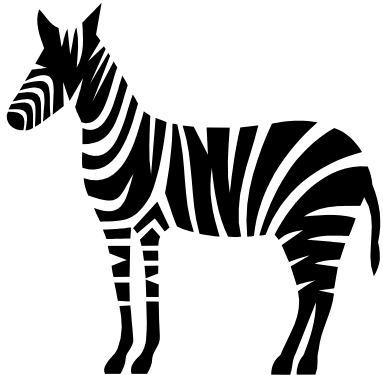
Making choices on a Budget

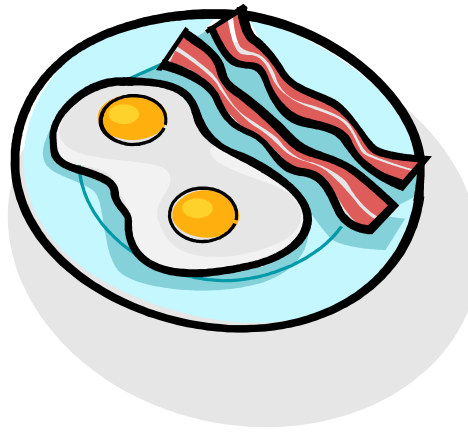
